## VizPIN 2022

It may seem like the pool season is a long way off, but before we know it, the district will be hiring lifeguards and preparing to open the gates for the pool — including the new adult pool and spa.

Please make certain that you are registered with the District's VizPIN system well ahead of the new season. As a reminder, this new VizPIN system was implemented last year, allowing residents the ability to use their mobile phone as their key to both the north pool and the tennis courts. In addition to providing contact-less access, the district now has better insight into pool and tennis court usage patterns and occupancy rates, enhanced safety during off-hours, and an increased ability to ensure only current and authorized residents are using the facilities.

Given the tragic Marshall Fire that happened on Dec. 30, 2021 in Superior and Louisville, we want to remind neighbors to be mindful of fire safety in the area. Long periods of drought have left many communities in the greater Denver Metro region prone to grass fires, even during the winter months.

Please do your part in ensuring there are not combustible items stored unsafely on or around your property, that you keep an eye on anything that could spark or cause a flame of any kind, and that we work together to prioritize community safety.

We encourage residents to visit a helpful page created by the Douglas County Office of Emergency Management for specific tips, including how to ensure each member of your family is signed up for CodeRED alerts for the area. <https://www.douglas.co.us/wildfire-information/>

**Some helpful tips from the Douglas County OEM Website:**

- Make sure your gutters and roof valleys are free of pine needles, leaves, and debris
- Mow grasses regularly, keep the grass short and well-watered to hinder the spread of flames
- Space out trees and shrubs, making it harder for flames to travel and easier for firefighters to work
- Prune branches to prevent flames from jumping from branches to house
- Seal off openings such as pet doors and attics with screens to prevent embers from getting through
- If you have a wooden roof, improve it with fire-resistant ceramic tiles, slate or composite shingles, or metal sheets
- Don't leave flammable material such as trash, lawn furniture, or propane tanks against the outside of your home or under decks
- Make sure not to mulch near your house or plant shrubs up against the exterior of your home


