

**INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
AMONG
LINCOLN PARK METROPOLITAN DISTRICT D/B/A STONEGATE NORTH
VILLAGES METROPOLITAN DISTRICT
AND
STONEGATE VILLAGE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT
REGARDING ENFORCEMENT OF PARKS FACILITIES RULES AND
REGULATIONS**

This Intergovernmental Agreement is entered into this 5th day of October 2023, among the **LINCOLN PARK METROPOLITAN DISTRICT d/b/a STONEGATE NORTH VILLAGES METROPOLITAN DISTRICT** (“SNV”), and **STONEGATE VILLAGE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT** (“SMD”) regarding reciprocal enforcement of expulsions, bars and bans from shared recreational amenities and other matters related to the enforcement of parks facilities rules and regulations.

RECITALS

A. SNV and SMD each own significant park and recreation facilities within their boundaries. Those facilities include *inter alia*, swimming pools and water facilities, tennis courts, parks, picnic areas and playgrounds (the “**Parks Facilities**”)

B. The parties entered a Memorandum of Understanding Concerning Development and Construction in 1998 concerning the parks and recreation facilities (“**MOU**”).

C. The MOU acknowledged that “it is impracticable to restrict the use of those amenities so as to differentiate between [SNV] and [SMD] residents. Accordingly, residents and property owners of [SNV] may freely use any Park Facility of [SMD] on a first come, first served basis, and residents and property owners of [SMD] may freely use any Park Facility of [SNV] on a first come, first served basis” See, MOU, Section C. 2.

D. Each party has policies, procedures and rules and regulations governing the use of their respective Parks Facilities by their own residents, residents within the other party’s jurisdiction and visitors from outside the respective boundaries (their “**Rules and Regulations**”).

E. The parties pledged in the MOU to work together to create “joint rules and regulations” for the operations of the Parks Facilities.

Now, therefore, the Parties enter into this Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Enforcement of Parks Facilities Rules and Regulations.

AGREEMENT

1. Individuals or entities subject to temporary or permanent suspension of privileges, expelled, banned or barred, or otherwise restricted, from the use of one parties’ Parks Facilities

may be deemed suspended, expelled, banned or barred, or otherwise restricted, from the use of the other parties' Parks Facilities.


2. Any other disciplinary actions of one party may be deemed the disciplinary actions of the other party and be enforced in and at all Parks Facilities.

3. Each party will amend its policies and procedures governing its Parks Facilities and any posted or published rules as necessary to provide notice that disciplinary actions taken or imposed by SMD may be enforced in the Parks Facilities of SVN, and that disciplinary actions taken or imposed by SVN may be enforced in the Parks Facilities of SMD consistent with the purpose and intent of this Agreement.

4. The Parties' managers will cooperate to determine the best way to implement the intentions of this Agreement and to develop a communications system to notify one another of disciplinary actions which shall include the reason for the disciplinary action and all information necessary to identify the disciplined individual(s) and/or entity(ies).

5. This Agreement shall be effective August 1, 2023. This Agreement may be amended upon mutual written agreement of the parties. This Agreement may be terminated for any reason by either party upon written notice to the other party.


